Notice:

Sweden will support basic and applied natural, social and health research and translation for use. All applicants have to comply with the rules as described in the Call Text.

Eligibility:

Public and private scientific institutions; universities and other higher educational institutions, which have been approved as an administrating organisation by Forte or Vetenskapsrådet and have an organisational account in the Swedish application system, Prisma.

The Swedish main applicant must hold a doctoral degree at the start of the project.

You may apply for this grant if you hold an ongoing grant at Vetenskapsrådet or Forte. You may only submit one application for this grant under this call. You may concurrently apply for other grants at Vetenskapsrådet or Forte. Your application must include a minimum of 1 and up to 5 participating researchers for the Swedish part of the project. Participating researchers must hold a doctoral degree.

If you have been the project leader for concluded grants from either Vetenskapsrådet or Forte, final financial reports must have been submitted within the permitted time frame in order for you to apply for a new grant. Please contact the administrating organisation if you are unsure whether all your final reports have been submitted.

Funding modalities:

The total funding available to Swedish participants is 18 MSEK. Maximum funding per proposal is 1.5 MSEK/year. Funding may be used for salaries, equipment, travelling and indirect costs. Funding must commence in January 2020 and the project period is maximum 36 months. A no cost extension period of 12 months will be included in the grant agreement. The date for final reporting will be by March 2024.
