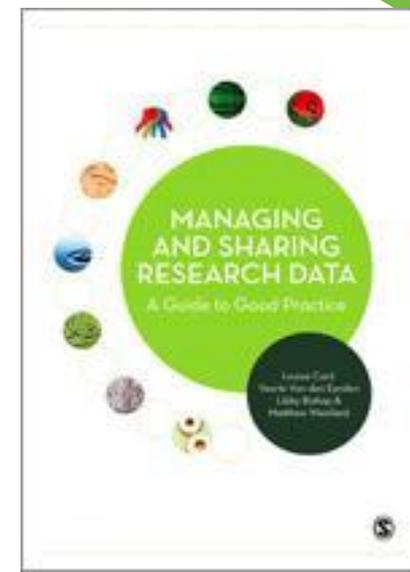

Upskilling for data curators

- Conundrum: Offer detailed RDM training externally, many of our staff are not as trained
- **New and novel forms of data:** huge step up for social science data archives. Organisationally disruptive
- Move away from manual QA methods for publishing data
- **Deliver cross-disciplinary working opportunities**
- New roles – statisticians, data scientists
