Description/qualifications of eligible participants	The UK PI must be based at an organisation that is eligible to receive UKRI funding .
Stipulations for the maximum number of researchers in the consortium	No maximum.
Type of contribution + amount of contribution (K€)	Monetary €1,250,000 (full economic cost) €1,000,000 (80% fEC)
Maximum amount that can be requested per project or by researcher (K€)	€250,000 (full economic cost) (N.B. The full economic cost of the UK elements of any individual proposal can be up to €250,000. If your proposal is successful, AHRC will fund 80% of that full economic cost, i.e. €200,000)
Restrictions for use of funds	Please follow the rules and guidance that are set out in the AHRC Research Funding Guide when costing your proposal.
Specific themes within the call	In order for a proposal to be eligible to receive AHRC funding, the majority of the research that is being funded by the AHRC must lie within the Arts and Humanities.
