Duration of time	Up to 3 years
Country/(ies) or region supported	Rio de Janeiro, Brazil
Description/qualifications of eligible participants	Applicants from Rio de Janeiro must adhere to the overall rules and conditions of a Regular Research Grant ("APQ1"), as outlined by FAPERJ, superseded by the specific rules for this Call that must be requested to FAPERJ by email. The eligibility conditions and restrictions follow those of the APQ1 modality. The applicant from Rio de Janeiro must have at least a doctorate degree and be employed and/or have a statutory relationship with an ICT located in the State of Rio de Janeiro. The pre-proposal must be submitted to the Belmont Forum platform, but FAPERJ will eventually request the submission of the full proposal in its system
Stipulations for the maximum number of researchers in the consortium	Only one applicant researcher per proposal (consortium) can receive direct funds from FAPERJ; other local researchers are welcomed as "associates"
Type of contribution + amount of contribution (R\$)	Monetary Total amount contribution of R\$ 2 million (aprox EUR 340 thousand)
Maximum amount that can be requested per project or by researcher (R\$)	R\$200K Details on budget conditions and limitations should be consulted with FAPERJ
Restrictions for use of funds	The usual conditions of Basic Research Grant 1 (APQ1) apply, in addition to the specific limitations for this call.
Specific themes within the Call	No specific themes of preference
