Available funding

Depending on all conditions of eligibility and peer review being met, the budget earmarked by RCN to Norwegian researchers for this call will be up to 620 k€ (according to exchange rates at time of funding). The available funding is 6 000 000,- NOK.

Eligibility and national funding modalities

Norwegian applicants may apply for a maximum of 100 k€ for participation in a project and a maximum of 150 k€ (according to exchange rates at time of funding) if the applicant is coordinating the project as Lead Principal Investigator.

The RCN funding is available for Norwegian researchers. Grants for research projects can only be administered by organisations being approved as research organisations by RCN. For definition and list of approved organisations please see [definition of research organisations](#).

It is expected that applications to this call will be Collaborative Research Grants with the consortium composition as defined in the call documents, and RCN will fund the Norwegian partner of any successful trans-national collaboration.

In addition, to benefit from the additional geographic breadth, all proposals involving Norwegian researchers should include at least one Belmont Forum country outside Europe. Researchers from countries not represented by any of the partner-countries are welcome to participate in the research projects at their own expense.

Climate friendly research

Projects receiving funding from the RCN under the present call are asked to consider climate friendly research and allow for virtual meeting participation by video and select venue and meeting times that keep distances travelled to a minimum.

The funding procedure will follow RCNs normal procedures for funding for approved proposal(s) for research project(s).
