- The total value of the Teagasc budget in applications cannot exceed €85,000 (including permanent staff time and indirect costs).
- All applications from Teagasc staff must be approved in advance by the Director of Research. In order to allow for the most efficient use of time, researchers are advised to consult with the National Contact Point at an early stage to make sure that their topic is in line with Teagasc research priorities.
