Duration of time:	The project period is a maximum of 36 months. A no-cost extension of up to 12 months may be granted upon request.
Country/(ies) supported	Chinese Taipei
Description/qualifications of eligible participants	Only research organizations, such as universities, university colleges, research institutes, or other entities engaged in research activities, that are eligible to receive funding from the NSTC may apply for this call. Other sectors (e.g., stakeholders, industries, or companies) wishing to participate must secure their own funding, either through self-financing or from other national funding agencies. Proof of secured funding must be provided to the NSTC upon request.
Stipulations for the maximum number of researchers in the consortium	There are no stipulations regarding the maximum number of researchers in the consortium.
Type of contribution + amount of contribution (K€)	Subject to the fulfillment of all eligibility criteria and a successful peer review, the total budget allocated by the NSTC for this call will be up to €500K, based on the exchange rate applicable at the time of funding.
Maximum amount that can be requested per project or by researcher (K€)	Subject to the fulfillment of all eligibility criteria and a successful peer review, the budget allocated by the NSTC for this call will be up to €250K per project or €500K for a project/consortium coordination (LPI being from Chinese Taipei).

Where to submit proposal	Proposals should be submitted to both www.bfgo.org and through the NSTC's year-end proposal submission process.

[Additional information]	Each Taiwanese team may request no more than 3 million New Taiwan Dollars (NTD) per year from the NSTC. For each successful Resilience research project, the NSTC will conduct a separate budget evaluation (rather than a technical evaluation) to determine the final approved amount. It is expected that applications to this call will be submitted as Collaborative Research Grants, with the consortium composition defined in the call document. The NSTC will provide funding to the Taiwanese partner of any successful transnational collaboration.
