## **Annex for Research Council of Norway (RCN)**

Duration of time:	3 years. With the possibility to apply for extension of one year if needed.
Country/(ies) supported	The RCN funding is available for approved Norwegian research organisations.
Description/qualifications of eligible participants	The project principal investigator must have an approved doctoral degree or equivalent before the application deadline. Grants for projects can only be administered by RCN approved research organizations. See <u>list of approved research organisations</u>
Stipulations for the maximum number of researchers in the consortium	To be decided by the applicants. RCN does not set a maximum number of researchers. The applicant must consider the maximum available funding per project against the number of researchers to be included.
	Monetary contribution. Available RCN funding is 17 mill NOK, i.e. ca 1,47 K€.
	Depending on the volume of submitted and eligible projects, up to 25 % additional funding may be allocated to the call to fund additional projects on the ranking list.
Maximum amount that can be requested per project or by researcher (K€)	Maximum amount requested by Norwegian partners per project is 250 K€
Restrictions for use of funds	Norwegian partners can apply for funding to cover actual costs necessary to carry out the project.
Specific themes within the call	RCN has no preferences to specific themes. Call text applies.
