The project must include collaboration between natural and social sciences and must show clear links to end users/stakeholders.</p> <p>Researchers from countries not represented by any of the partner-countries can participate in the research project at their own expense but do not count toward the 3 participating country minimum.</p>
Type of contribution + amount of contribution (K€)	<p>Monetary</p> <p>Available budget from NRCT is approximately 9,000,000 THB</p>
Maximum amount that can be requested per project or by researcher (K€)	<p>The maximum funding allocated per project is 4,500,000 THB* (up to 1,500,000 THB per year) (*This is an approximate funding depend on the research content).</p>
