Duration of time:	DFG supports projects running up to three years.
Country/(ies) supported	DFG applies the usual eligibility criteria supporting researchers affiliated to German universities and non-university research institutions (please see DFG, German Research Foundation - Principles of Eligibility)
Description/qualifications of eligible participants	See above
Stipulations for the maximum number of researchers in the consortium	No formal restrictions
Type of contribution + amount of contribution (K€)	Financial support of projects (altogether 3 Mio. € at max.) Overheads for the German partners will be added automatically.
Maximum amount that can be requested per project or by researcher (K€)	No formal restriction. However, requested amounts per project should be in line with the requested amounts by other international partners involved in a project proposal.
Restrictions for use of funds	German parts of proposals to this call will be funded through the DFG Programme “Individual Research Grants“ (see on our homepage Guidelines document 50.1 Guidelines Research Grants Programme). Applicants should read and follow DFG forms and guidelines for Research Grants.
Specific themes within the call	Please note that German parts of proposals that cover mainly Geographical topics cannot be covered by DFG funds. Engagement with users is welcome and an important prerequisite to submit proposals, but users are not eligible to apply for DFG funding.
Where to submit proposal	www.bfgo.org Please note: All applicants requesting funding from DFG are required to additionally submit their CRA proposals through the DFG’s elan system (https://elan.dfg.de). Proposals with German applicants that are not entered into elan will be rejected. Please note the following instructions for submission:

It takes the DFG 1-2 business days to process the registration, so make sure you are registered well ahead of the deadline. • Deadline for elan submission of registration proposals: 23 October 2025 • Deadline for elan submission of full proposals: one week later than the official deadline for BFGo submission • Funding scheme: Individual Research Grant (Sachbeihilfe) • Call to select: CRA Resilience 2025 • Title and Summary: You do not have to translate either from English into German. Just copy/paste your English title and summary into the boxes that call for the information in German. • Pls from the other participating countries are to be added as “Participating Individuals” in the role of “Cooperation Partner”.
