Duration of time:	<i>Two years duration, extendable for one more year, if necessary</i>
Country/(ies) supported	<i>Brazil, exclusively applicants/researchers from the state of Santa Catarina</i>
Description/qualifications of eligible participants	<i>The applicant must have a PhD and be employed by a research institute in Santa Catarina. Applicants from Santa Catarina must adhere to the overall rules and conditions of a Research Grant, as outlined by FAPESC, available at www.fapesc.sc.gov.br, superseded by the specific guidelines for this Call. Eligibility conditions and restrictions follow those of the Research Grant modality, with an additional requirement for well-established researchers with a proven track record of interdisciplinary international projects in the themes of the Call.</i>
Stipulations for the maximum number of researchers in the consortium	<i>Only one candidate researcher per proposal (consortium) may receive direct resources from FAPESC. FAPESC will support up to 04 research projects</i>
Type of contribution + amount of contribution (K€)	<i>Monetary R\$ 1,500,000.00 (one million, five hundred thousand reais), which corresponds to approximately € 234,599 (two hundred and thirty-four thousand, five hundred and ninety-nine euros), according to the current exchange rate (subject to change in euros)</i>
Maximum amount that can be requested per project or by researcher (K€)	<i>an individual amount of R\$ 375,000.00 (three hundred and seventy-five thousand reais) per project, equivalent to approximately € 58,649 (fifty-eight thousand, six hundred and forty-nine euros), according to the current exchange rate ((subject to change in euros)</i>
Restrictions for use of funds	<i>Expenses will be stipulated and divided between cost and capital. Usual conditions of FAPESC research. Grants apply, plus the limitations specific for this Call, i.e., equipment, and software licenses</i>
