<b>Description/qualifications of eligible participants</b>	<p>AXA funding is open to non-profit organizations which serve the public interest such as : associations, hospitals, government, national, regional &amp; International NGOs<sup>1</sup>.</p> <p><b>Note:</b> Researchers affiliated with universities, academic institutions, and industries are not eligible for AXA funding. Projects focused on research and development, company creation, or educational programs are not eligible for funding.</p>
<b>Stipulations for the maximum number of researchers in the consortium</b>	N/A
<b>Type of contribution + amount of contribution (K€)</b>	Monetary
<b>Maximum amount that can be requested per project or by researcher (K€)</b>	Subject to meeting all eligibility criteria and successful peer review, AXA allocates up to €150,000 per project.

<sup>1</sup> To be eligible for AXA funding, organizations must notably meet the following criteria:

1. Have a minimum of two years of existence.
2. Submit a project with a budget that does not exceed 33% of the organization's annual budget.
3. Demonstrate ethical and responsible practices aligned with AXA's values of integrity, solidarity, and human progress.
